# Program

- **Speakers**

We are proud to have prominent leaders and innovators in medicine speak on diverse topics.

- **Research and Discovery**

Students can research a topic of interest, write a manuscript, and submit to the IYRC for publication.

- **Narrative Presentations**

Students capture stories in a medical context by sharing patient and community voices.

- **Community Projects**

Students can receive guidance to implement a concrete intervention to improve their community.

- **Asynchronous Modules**

Students engage in asynchronous learning throughout the week creating a flexible environment for learning

- **Synchronous Didactics**

Students gather on weekends for a Zoom discussion led by physicians, researchers, and students.
